2. Who can apply for the awards?

The awards are open to applications from individuals across all backgrounds and sectors.

3. Why should I apply for the awards?

- **Gain Global Recognition:** The Innovation Awards provide global recognition, judged by top leaders in Digital Health. They honour outstanding products and services that demonstrate impactful innovation.
- **Network with Industry Leaders:** The Awards ceremony attracts industry leaders and key decision-makers, offering a prime opportunity to network and connect with potential collaborators in Digital Health.
- **Global Exposure:** Winners and finalists will receive extensive exposure through this, allowing you to reach a wide audience of Digital Health professionals and enthusiasts from around the world.
- **Social Media Outreach:** Winners are featured on our social media, giving them Global visibility and reach.

4. How to apply for sub-category?

- Register/Login with your contact number or email ID
- Fill in the basic details
- Make payment
- Complete the detail form
- Register separately as a delegate if not done already

6. Is delegate registration mandatory to apply?

Yes, a separate delegate registration is required to be considered eligible for the awards.

The process begins with submitting a basic form containing your name and email. Once the payment is completed, you will gain access to the detailed form to provide all necessary information for the awards.

9. What recognition do winners receive?

- Trophy by the Jury
- Global visibility through features on social media platforms of the summit
- Recognition in front of industry leaders, innovators, and key decision-makers
- Opportunity to network and connect with collaborators in Digital Health

10. What are the assessment criteria for the mentioned categories?

- **Innovation** - How is the product/ service disruptive? Is it a niche offering which has no precedent?
- **Accessibility** - Geographic penetration, socio-economic strata, technology, infrastructure
- **Availability** - Services, just-in-time solutions, customisation of offerings, manpower, equipment, technology usage
- **Delivery of Care** - Outcomes, accreditation, delivery of optimal care, data for measurement of quality outcomes
- **Affordability** - Price, financing, affordability by economic class, health insurance, partnerships
- **Impact** - Measurement on people & outcomes, disease, lifestyle & duration of service, individual or institutionalized

Yes, organizations may submit entries in multiple categories if appropriate.

18. Are international applicants eligible for the awards?

Yes, the awards are open to both national and international applicants.

23. Who can apply for the awards?

Eligible applicants include Government Agencies, NGOs, Academic Institutions, Industry Professionals, Startups, and Individual Innovators in Digital Health or healthcare. Both national and international entries are welcome.



24. What are the criteria to apply for the awards?

Applicants must demonstrate notable innovation, measurable impact, scalability, sustainability, and relevance to healthcare. Submissions should align with the summit's objectives of advancing healthcare through technology.

25. Are supporting documents required or encouraged?

Yes, applicants may submit additional documents such as data reports, testimonials, product demos, or case studies to strengthen their application. The form does not allow any uploads so for sharing any additional documents, kindly share with us via email:

27. What is the application deadline? Can it be extended?

Application deadline is till 15th August 2025. Extensions are granted, and late entries are typically not accepted.
