



Multistakeholder Consultation on India's One Health Policy Framework

Health Parliament (a global think-tank on health), in collaboration with Brooke India (an international equine welfare organization) and other key stakeholders, undertook a comprehensive assessment of the Status of One Health in India. This work culminated in a report released by Dr. Vinod Paul, Member (Health), NITI Aayog, on 7th April 2025

during International Patients' Union Conference. The findings underscored the urgent need for an integrated approach to human, animal, and environmental health.

Following this release, we initiated the process of drafting the One Health Policy Framework for India, an ambitious national framework that is now in its final stages of development. The framework is designed to align India's public health priorities with global best practices, ensuring a resilient, multi-sectoral approach to health governance.



The Multistakeholder Consultation on India's One Health Policy Framework, to be held during the Global Digital Health Summit on 19th September 2025 from 02.00 PM to 05.00 PM will bring together senior policymakers, domain experts, and institutional leaders to deliberate on the emerging recommendations of the draft One Health Policy Framework. The discussion will extend beyond a review of ideas, serving as a structured policy dialogue to refine and shape the final framework of the national policy.

All deliberations will be recorded, transcribed, and systematically incorporated into the final version of the policy framework. *Contributors to the session will be formally acknowledged in the final policy paper.*

Expected Outcomes

The session will generate consensus on priority actions, strengthen inter-sectoral collaboration, and ensure that India's One Health Policy Framework is shaped by the collective wisdom and expertise of a multi-stakeholder consultation.
